Topic:

Prior to hiring a consultant, the subrogation professional can research and obtain information that will help them determine if further investigation by a consultant is even necessary. The professional needs to ask key questions about the loss and know where to conduct their research. If the decision to pursue a claim is based on understanding technical data, a consultant can interpret the information and may have further knowledge about similar losses and potential defendants based on their own experience. Costs can be managed by limiting the consultant's work to specific areas. Litigating the loss requires an expert, and a proper selection provides the subrogation professional with a resource that helps them manage the focus of the case and the best use of the expert's time.
