The Future of Claims Against International Defendants and the Foreign Manufacturers Legal Accountability Act (FMLAA)

Brisco also recently presented this topic at the 2011 NASP National Conference in Orlando, Florida.

The participants will also learn about a current bill in front of Congress entitled the Foreign Manufacturers Legal Accountability Act (FMLAA).

Description of Presentation and Topics to be Covered (200 Words or Less):

This presentation is designed to provide an analysis of filing suit against foreign manufacturers in United States Courts. Furthermore, the participants will learn about the procedure for serving process on a foreign manufacturer as well as what factors and evidence are needed to establish jurisdiction over foreign manufacturers in U.S. Courts. Moreover, the presentation will discuss an expected hot topic in U.S. politics this year - the Foreign Manufacturers Legal Accountability Act - currently expected to be passed by Congress in the near future. Finally, the participants will learn additional factors that must be weighed in determining whether to file suit against a foreign manufacturer, including whether the judgment is enforceable overseas where the defendant likely has most of its assets.
